Science ASSIST is a new and innovative national online advisory service for school science educators and technicians. It will be freely available to ALL Australian schools from ALL education jurisdictions and sectors in EVERY state and territory.

Who will manage Science ASSIST?

Science ASSIST is managed by the Australian Science Teachers Association (ASTA) in consultation with Science Education Technicians Australia (SETA). It is funded by the Department of Education, Employment and Workplace Relations (DEEWR).

What will Science ASSIST provide?
